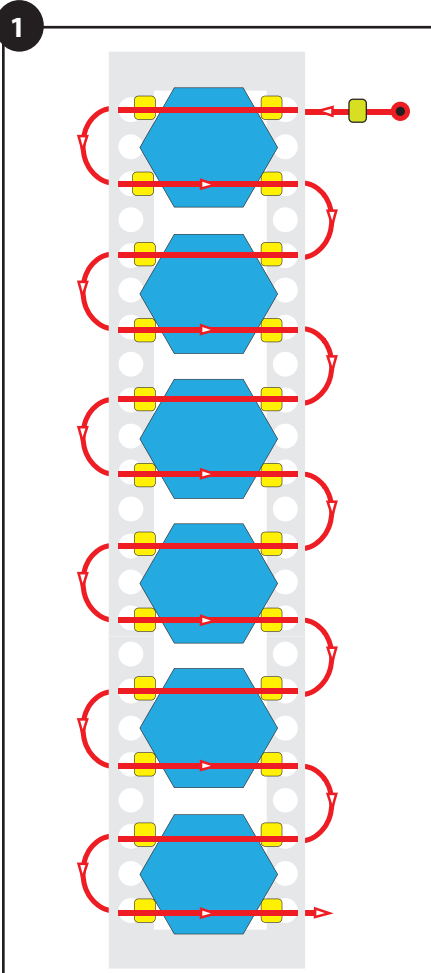

- (1 tube) **SB00402** - 11/0 Metallic Bronze Miyuki Seed Bead
- (1 spool) **A006587** - Smoke Fireline Thread
- A015211** - Beading Needle

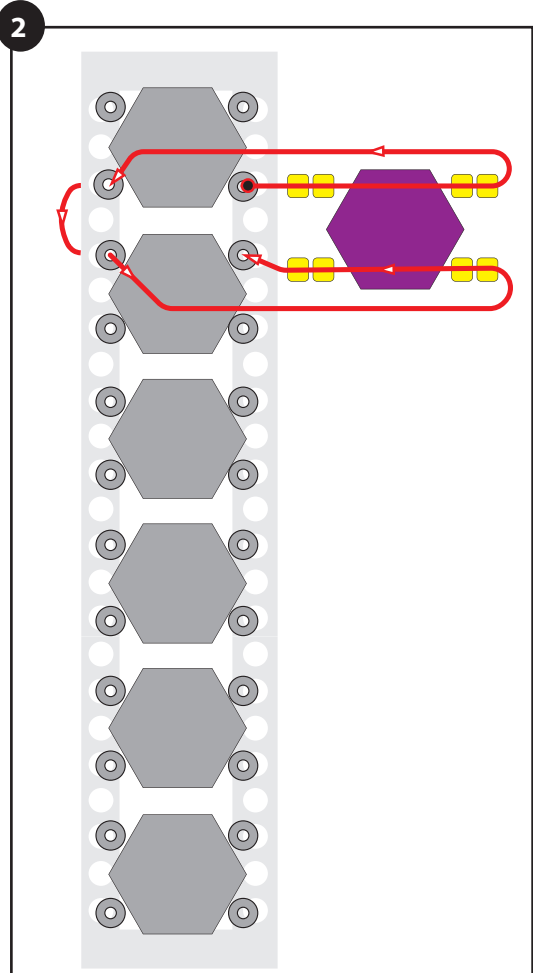


Instructions

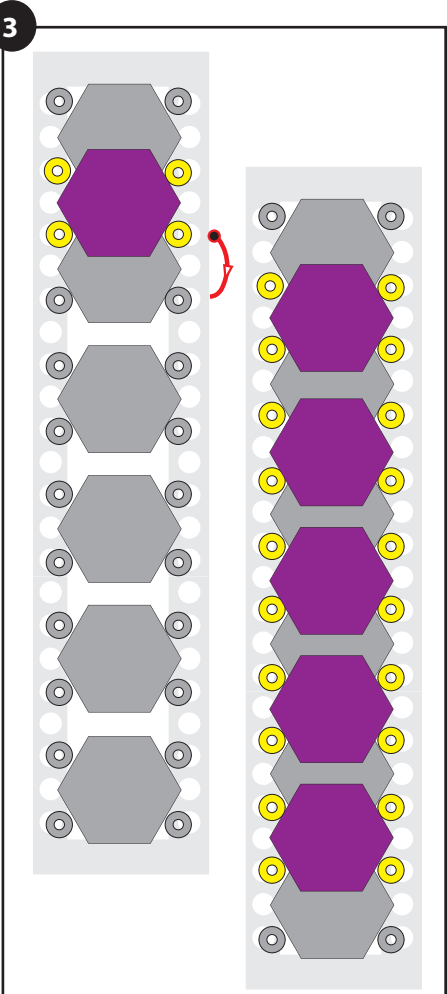


Start with 4 feet of beading thread. Add a stopper bead to your thread by sewing through a seed bead twice. Follow illustration to add seed bead and honeycombs by weaving and sewing through the holes on the beadable cuff.

Once you are done, sew back through the beads to end where Step 2 starts.



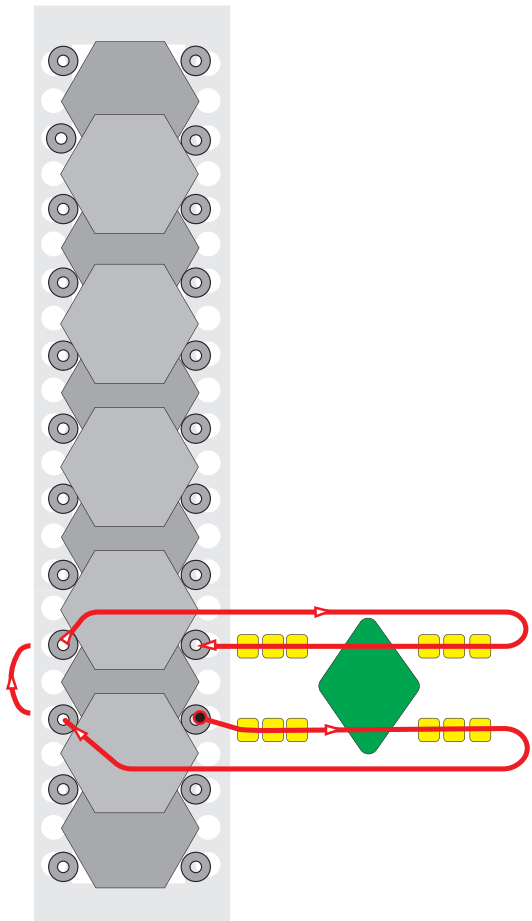
Sew through the seed bead already sew on cuff, add two seed beads, honeycomb beads (new color) and two more seed beads. Cross over to sew down through seed bead and hole of beadable cuff. Sew down a row and up the beadable cuff and seed bead. Add two seed beads, sew through second hole of honeycombe bead, add two seed beads and down through seed bead directly across.



Sew down and up through next seed bead.

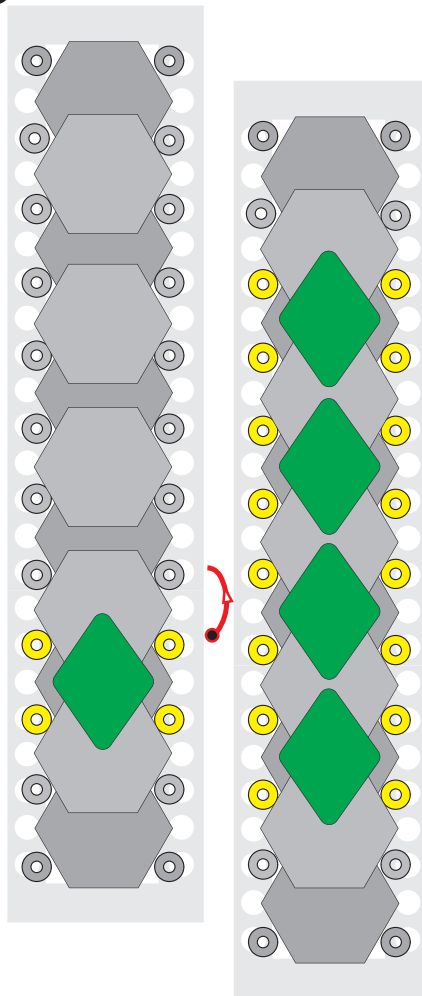
Repeat Step 2, FOUR more times.

Sew up through bottom, third seed bead. Follow illustration to adding seed beads and DiamonDuo bead.

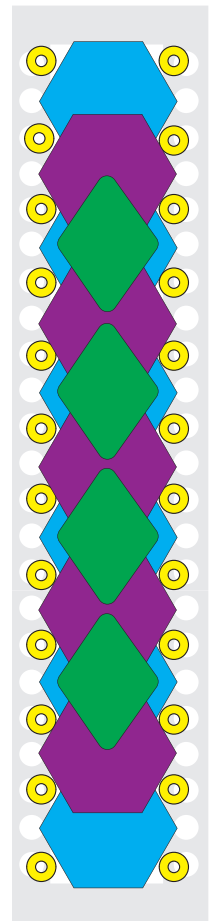

Sew up through next seed bead.

Repeat Step 4, THREE more times.

Tie off and cut excess beading thread. Add a small drop/dab of glue to secure knots.
