Playful Tila Bracelet with Cymbal Bead Endings

## Components

SB00870 - Opaque Turquoise Tila Bead
SB01934 - Matte Metallic Khaki Iris Half Tila
Z012249-Cymbal Soros Silver Plated
A006588 - Smoke Fireline Thread
A015211 - Beading Needle
Jump Rings and Clasp of Choice


Instructions

1


Using a 4 feet piece of beading thread, sew through one half Tila bead, Cymbal and another half Tila bead

Sew up the other hole of the half Tila bead and pick up a Tila bead and through the second hole of first half Tila. Leaving a good 5 inch thread tail, tie the thread ends together.

SEW through the sequence of beads once more.

Repeat Steps 3, while subsituting the Tila bead for another Cymbal.

## 2



Pick up a half Tila bead and sew through second hole of Tila bead.

Pick up a half Tila and through previous half Tila. Loop through the sequence of beads halfway through the second half Tila you've added.

Sew through the second hole of the half Tila, pick up a Tila bead and sew through the second hole of the first half Tila in this Step.

6


Sew through the sequence of beads again to secure pattern. Tie off ends and cut off excess beading thread.

3


Sew down and up through previously added beads to secure this section of the pattern.

Repeat Step 2
4
Repeat Step 3 for another 29 more times, completing with a total of 32 Tilas for an average $7.5^{\prime \prime}$ wrist size.

Adjust the bracelet length by adding or lessening Tila sequences.

Open jump rings and attach your choice if clasp ends.
