

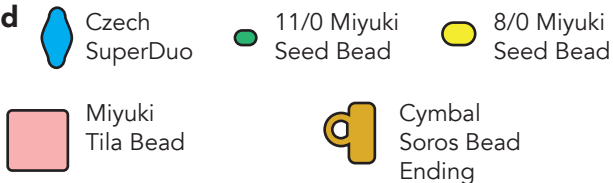


## Tila Stripe Bracelet with Cymbal Bead Endings

### Components

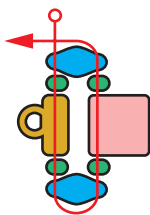
SB00870 - Opaque Turquoise Tila Bead  
 SB01406 - Jet SuperDuo  
 SB00107 - 8/0 Galvanized Gold Seed Bead  
 SB00402 - 11/0 Metallic Dark Bronze Seed Bead  
 Z012250 - Cymbal Soros 24K Gold Plated  
 A006588 - Smoke Fireline Thread  
 A015211 - Beading Needle  
 Jump Rings and Clasp of Choice

### Instructions

1

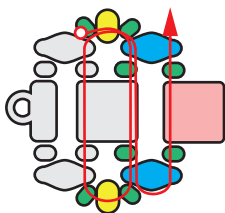


Using a 4 feet piece of beading thread, sew through the following bead and finding: Superduo, 11/0, Cymbal, 11/0 and SuperDuo.

Sew up the other hole of the SuperDuo and pick up a 11/0, Tila bead and 11/0. Sew through second hole of the first SuperDuo. Leaving a good 5 inch thread tail, tie the thread ends together.

SEW through the sequence of beads once more.

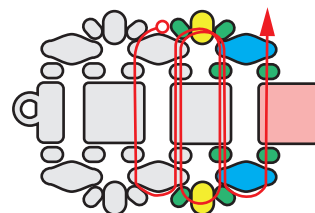


Pick up a 11/0, 8/0, 11/0, SuperDuo and 11/0. Sew through second hole of Tila bead.

Pick up a 11/0, SuperDuo, 11/0, 8/0, 11/0 and through previous SuperDuo. Loop through the sequence of beads halfway through the second SuperDuo you've added.

Sew through the second hole of the SuperDuo, pick up 11/0, Tila bead and 11/0. Sew through the second hole of the first SuperDuo in this Step.

Sew down and up through previously added beads to secure this section of the pattern.

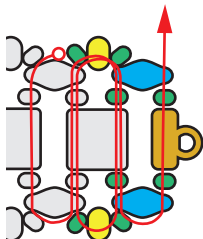
Repeat Step 2

Repeat Step 3 for another 17 more times, completing with a total of 20 Tilas for an average 7.5" wrist size.

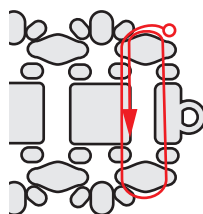
Adjust the bracelet length by adding or lessening Tila sequences.

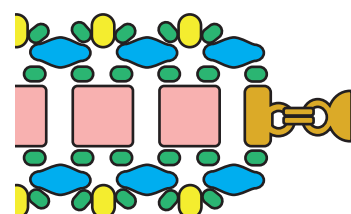
Repeat Steps 3, while substituting the Tila bead for another Cymbal.

Sew through the sequence of beads again to secure pattern. Tie off ends and cut off excess beading thread.

Open two jump rings and attach your choice if clasp ends.
