




## Long Cubed Tube Tassel Earrings

### Components


**SB03963** - Turquoise Two Hole Bar Czech Bead  
**SB00422** - 11/0 Galvanized Silver Seed Bead  
**SB00106** - 8/0 Galvanized Silver Seed Bead  
**A006587** - 6lb Crystal Fireline Thread  
**TCZ0078** - Coil Earring Wire by TierraCast®  
**Z014017** - Royal Blue Tassel with Silver Cap  
**A002413** - 4mm Round Silver Jump Ring

### Instructions


**1** Start with a 4-5 feet piece of beading thread. Sew and add a stopper bead to your thread end, leaving a 5 inch tail.




Pick up 11 Czech bar beads, an 11/0 seed bead, 8/0 seed bead, 11/0 seed bead and another Czech bar bead. Sew through the 10th bar you added and pick up a bar bead. Skip a bar bead and sew through the next bar bead and pick up another. Repeat and add 4 more bar beads.

Pick up an 11/0, 8/0 and 11/0 seed bead and loop around pattern again and coming out through last bar bead in pattern. (Refer to illustration).

Note: do not tie thread ends together.



Sew through other hole of bar bead and pick up a Czech bar bead. Follow illustration to adding 4 more bar beads.



Fold bar ends together. The previous section should zip with first section of bars you added in step 1, creating a cube tube.

While holding all the pattern, pick up an 11/0 seed bead, sew through top 8/0 seed bead, pick up another 11/0 and sew down through the zipped sides to bring your pattern together. Pick up another 11/0 sew through bottom 8/0 seed bead, pick up another 11/0 and sew through bars.

**5** To strengthen your tube, sew through tube again, looping around and following the patterns a couple of times. Once you have a sturdy cubed tube, tie off and cut off excess. Sew thread end through a few beads before tying off and cutting off excess.

**6** Use jump rings to attach tassel or earwire to bottom and top 8/0 seed bead.

**7** Repeat all steps for other earring.
