- SB00444** - 11/0 Matte Cream Seed Beads
- SB00423** - 11/0 Galvanized Gold Seed Beads
- SB00447** - 11/0 Dyed Wine Seed Beads
- TCZ0148** - TierraCast Earwire
- A006599** - Size AA White Superlon Beading Thread Bobbin
- A006767** - Beading Needle

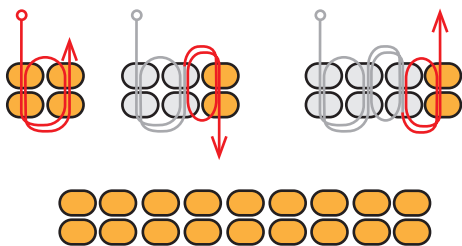

Instructions

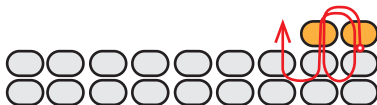
1 Add a stopper bead to a 4-5 feet piece of beading thread.

Sew on 4 seed beads. Loop around the beads twice and situate two beads side-by-side.

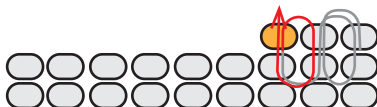
Pick up 2 seed beads and loop through the the two you just came through. Repeat according to the illustration to create 2 rows of 9 beads.



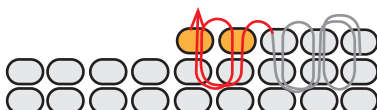
2 Pick up two seed beads and follow the illustration to makes your third row.



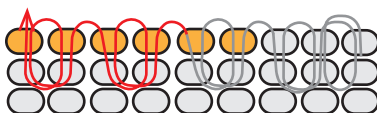
Pick up one seed beads and follow illustration to link the rows.



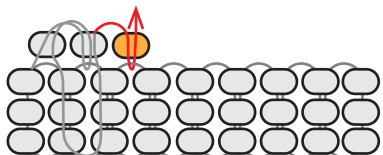
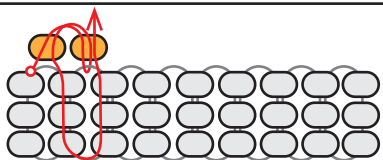
Follow the illustration to adding two more seed beads.



Repeat until you've made your third row of 9 beads.

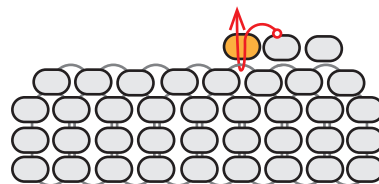
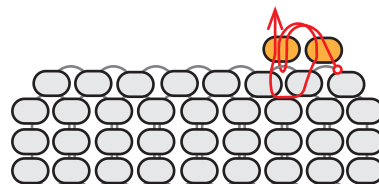


3 For the fourth row, we will brick stitch with 8 beads. First pick up 2 seed beads, sew under the second thread (that connects the second and third row) and up through the one seed bead and down through the other bead. Follow illustration to secure this first section.



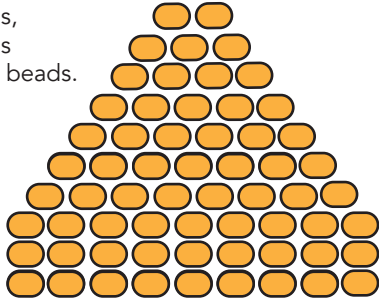
Pick up another seed bead and brick stitch. Repeat for another 5 seed beads.

4 Repeat step 3 to create the fifth row. You will adding 7 beads in this row by brick stitching.



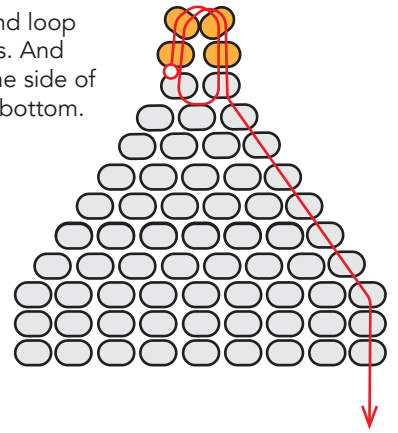

Repeat step 3 making the following row sequence:
 6th row with 6 beads,
 7th row with 5 beads,
 8th row with 4 beads,
 9th row with 3 beads
 and 10th row with 2 beads.

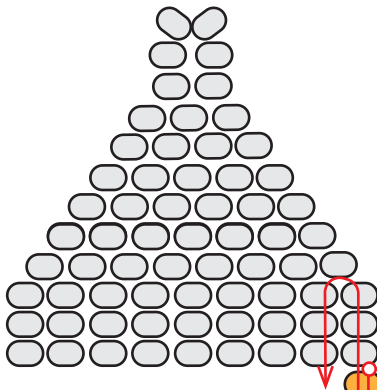

Pick up 4 beads to sew and loop around the top two beads. And follow illustration down the side of your pattern towards the bottom.

We will start by adding a fringe with the first fringe of:

5 A color (A color is your initial color you did in steps 1-6),
 1 B color,
 1 A color,
 2 B color,
 1 A color,
 7 B color,
 1 C color,
 1 B color,
 2 C color,
 1 B color,
 & 7 C color.

Sew back through all you've added, skipping the first bead at the bottom. Loop through the top and down through the next bead section to make your next fringe.

Repeat step 6 adding the following fringe sequence:

2nd Fringe: 8 A, 1 B, 1 A, 2 B, 1 A, 7 B, 1 C, 1 B, 2 C, 1 B, & 7 C.

3rd Fringe: 11 A, 1 B, 1 A, 2 B, 1 A, 7 B, 1 C, 1 B, 2 C, 1 B, & 7 C.

4th Fringe: 14 A, 1 B, 1 A, 2 B, 1 A, 7 B, 1 C, 1 B, 2 C, 1 B, & 7 C.

5th Fringe: 17 A, 1 B, 1 A, 2 B, 1 A, 7 B, 1 C, 1 B, 2 C, 1 B, & 7 C.

6th Fringe: 14 A, 1 B, 1 A, 2 B, 1 A, 7 B, 1 C, 1 B, 2 C, 1 B, & 7 C.

7th Fringe: 11 A, 1 B, 1 A, 2 B, 1 A, 7 B, 1 C, 1 B, 2 C, 1 B, & 7 C.

8th Fringe: 8 A, 1 B, 1 A, 2 B, 1 A, 7 B, 1 C, 1 B, 2 C, 1 B, & 7 C.

9th Fringe: 5 A, 1 B, 1 A, 2 B, 1 A, 7 B, 1 C, 1 B, 2 C, 1 B, & 7 C.

Once, you've finished your fringe, make sure to loosen your strands in each fringe so that the fringes aren't too tight so it dangles when moving and not too loose so there aren't threads showing.

Follow illustration to sew up through the pattern and loop around a few beads before cutting off excess.

Attach ear wire loop through the loop of beads at the top of your pattern. Repeat ALL steps for other earring.
