




## Leaf Drop & Straw Necklace with Beadable Accessories

### Components

- SB02336** - 11/0 Spruce Duracoat Opaque Dyed Delica Seed Beads
- SB00269** - 11/0 Galvanized Gold Miyuki Delica Seed Beads
- Z001659** - Handmade Woven Rattan Straw Oval Ring Pendant/Connector
- Z005131 (3)** - Gold-Plated Stainless Steel Beadable Rectangular Link
- Z018107** - 40mm Gold-Plated Stainless Steel Beadable Oval Pendant
- CH00532 (2)** - 2.2mm Gold Plated Soldered Cable Chain
- A008801** - 5mm Gold Plated 21 Gauge Oval Jump Rings
- A011523** - 8mm Gold Plated 20 Gauge Round Jump Ring
- A011517** - 4mm Gold Plated 20 Gauge Round Jump Ring
- A006587** - 6lb Crystal Fireline Thread
- A006767** - Beading Needles

### Instructions


Cut a 2 feet piece of beading thread, thread on needle and add a stopper bead to your thread end with a 6" tail.


Starting from the longest channel, sew up through the bottom hole and pick up 6 Spruce delica, 5 Galvanized Gold, 5 Spruce. Sew under the channel and up through the other hole of your channel. Sew back through the beads and sew down through the hole you've started out of. (fig.1)

Sew over and up through the next bottom hole of the next channel and pick up 5 Spruce, 4 Gold, 5 Spruce. Sew under the channel and up through the other hole of this channel. Sew back through the beads and sew down through the bottom hole.

Repeat with the other channels by adding 3 Spruce, 3 Gold, 3 Spruce to next channel. And 1 Spruce, 1 Gold, 1 Spruce to the last channel.

Tie off ends by making a knot with the connecting thread between channels. Slide under the connecting thread, pull needle and thread through until you create a small loop and feed needle through the loop. Gently pull your needle to make your knot. (fig.2) Make two knots. Sew through a few bead before cutting off excess.





Cut a 2-3 feet piece of beading thread, thread on needle and add a stopper bead to your thread end with a 6" tail.

Sew through a hole on the beadable link. Pick up 3 Spruce, 3 Gold and 3 Spruce. Sew down through the hole across the channel and sew back through all the beads. Tie both thread ends together twice. Sew up through the hole and through a few beads before cutting off excess. With other end, sew through a few more beads and cut off excess.

Repeat and make a total of 3 links.

**4.** Cut 2 inches off your 2 feet of chain.

**5.** Using a bead reamer, an awl or your round nose pliers, poke a hole in your straw component, between the top and second straw rows. And ream another hole at the opposite end. (fig. 3)

**6.** Open the larger 8mm jump ring, slide through one of the holes you made in the straw and through the loop of your leaf dangle in step 1. Close jump ring.

**7.** Open another 8mm jump ring, slide through other hole of the straw connector and through both pieces of chain (the 2" short chain and other longer piece of chain). Close jump ring.

**8.** Open a small jump ring and slide on one hole of your link in step 2 and through the other end of the 2" chain. Close jump ring. Open another small jump ring and slide through other hole of link.

**9.** Attach a small jump ring to another beadable link from step 2. And another jump ring on the other side.

**10.** Open an oval jump ring, slide through jump ring from step 8 and jump ring from step 9. Close jump ring.

**11.** Open a small jump ring, slide on one hole of the last beadable link and through the end of your longer piece of chain. Close jump ring. Open another small jump ring and slide through other hole of beadable link.

**12.** Open another oval jump ring, slide through the jump rings of your third and second beadable link. Close jump ring.
